

Cheque Handing Over event for Construction of “Schizophrenia Home”

(24th March,2021 @1:30 PM at Dhyan Room, Wagh Bakri House, Ahmedabad)

According to the WHO, ***schizophrenia*** is a severe mental disorder, characterised by disruptions in thinking, affecting language, perception, and the sense of self. It often includes psychotic experiences, such as hearing voices or delusions. The schizophrenic is disconnected from the reality of the world. The people suffering from this condition eventually lose their ability to take care of themselves.

To provide home for the homeless patients of schizophrenia **Sahyog Kushtha Yagna Trust** (“Sahyog”) is constructing “**Schizophrenia Home**”. The Schizophrenia Home is going to benefit the especially abled people and more specifically homeless schizophrenia patients to get shelter, proper counselling and medical treatment at free of cost.

Gujarat Tea Processors and Packers Limited (Wagh Bakri Tea Group) has come forward and committed CSR contribution of Rs. 1.07 crore to construct the home for schizophrenic patients. The Company had already contributed of Rs. 20 Lakhs for the same during the FY 2019-20. The construction work of the Schizophrenia home is in progress.

A CSR event has been organized to handover the Cheque of Rs. 37 Lakhs for the Schizophrenia Home to Sahyog in the august presence of ***Shri Raseshbhai Desai, Managing Director, Shri Paragbhai Desai, Executive Director, Shri Parasbhai Desai, Executive Director and Shri Priyambhai Parikh, Whole-time Director***. The ceremony was witnessed by the HODs from the Company. With the above, Wagh Bakri Tea Group till date has contributed in total Rs. 57 Lakhs out of total committed amount of Rs. 1.07 Crore for this CSR project.

Shri Raseshbhai Desai and Shri Parasbhai Desai acclaimed the efforts made by the organisation for the noble cause which will provide shelter home and treatment to schizophrenic patients.
